- Positive gene findings: When and how do we approach bereaved families with such findings?
- Sudden cardiac death
- Sudden infectious death
 - Apnoea – hypoxemia – death
- Starvation – a difficult diagnosis
- Unexplained still birth – intrauterine SIDS?
- The rise and fall of the triple risk/fatal triangle model?
- Investigation of sudden deaths in infancy and childhood
- Death scene investigation – is it necessary?
- Interviewing parents and children?
 - Who are qualified?
